Local Pool Trips: June 25, July 16, July 30 & August 13 (Fridays)

Depart 11:30 a.m. Return 3:30 p.m.

Children will enjoy an afternoon of fun in the water at Brunswick or Lovettsville pools. **Children are to bring bathing suits, towels, water shoes and hat & t-shirt.** Please make sure that your child's pool items are clearly labeled. Pool days are on Fridays throughout the summer.



Day at the Movies: July 1, July 22, August 19 (Thursdays)

Depart 9:30 a.m. Return 12:00 p.m. (10 a.m Show Times)

Children will enjoy a day at the movies at Holiday Cinemas off Rt. 40: July 1--Madagascar (PG), July 22--Cloudy with a Chance of Meatballs (PG), August 19--Shrek the Third (PG). **Parental permission is required for children to attend.**



Tuesday, June 29: Bowling & Lunch at Baker Park

Depart at 10:00 a.m. Return at 3:00 p.m.

The children will go bowling at Terrace Lanes Bowling Alley and enjoy lunch at Baker Park in Frederick. **Children are required to bring or wear socks for bowling.**



Thursdays in July/August "Alex's Lemonade Stand"

Depart 10:45 a.m. Return 1:15 p.m.

The children will take turns visiting the Brunswick Senior Center and help sell lemonade to support the "Alex Lemonade Stand." Each week three children will be transported to the Senior Center and stay for lunch. A list will be sent home indicating which day your child will attend. Attached you will find more information on "Alex's Lemonade Stand". We will be offering a donation jar at Educare to support this fundraiser as well.



Thursday, July 8: Frederick Keys Baseball Game (12:00 Game)

Depart 10:30 a.m. Return 4:00 p.m.

The children will attend a local Frederick Keys Baseball game and enjoy lunch outside the ballpark prior to first pitch. **Children are encouraged to wear a baseball cap or hat.**



Tuesday, August 3 (Ice skating, Lunch @ Park & Ice Cream)

Depart 10:00 a.m. Return 3:00 p.m.

The children will enjoy lunch at Staley Park followed by an afternoon of skating at Skate Frederick off of Route 26. **Children are asked to bring or wear socks to use with their skates.**

Note: Children 8 and under (unless greater than 4 feet 9 inches or weighing more than 65 pounds) are required to have a booster seat according to the Maryland State Law. Parents are responsible to leave a labeled booster seat for their child on the day of each field trip if applicable. If no booster seat is left for a child who requires one, the child will not be able to attend the field trip. The child will join Room 4 children until the School-age classroom returns from the field trip.

Reminders:

- The children will be transported by a member of administration on each field trip.
- **Children are asked to bring a bag lunch with a drink for all off-site field trips.** Please label the bag with the child's name.
- If a booster seat is necessary, please label the seat clearly with the child's name
- All entrance/transportation fees are provided by Educare. Money for snacks are optional.
- Children will be creating their own t-shirts to wear for off-site field trip days.
